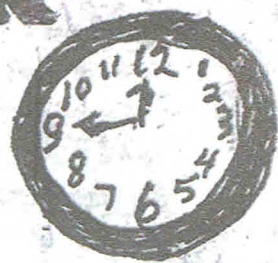

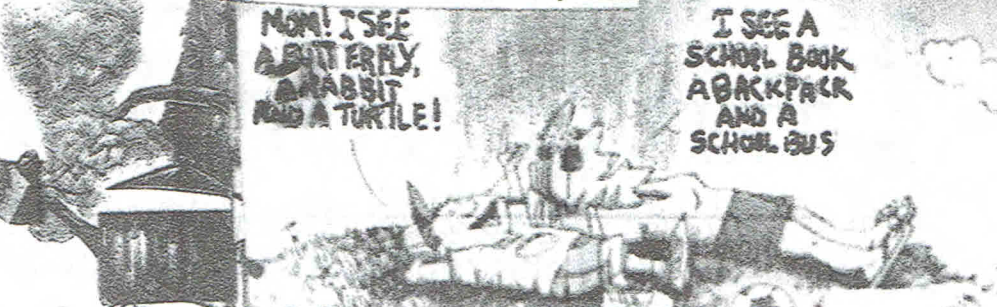

## IS THE CHURCH OF CHRIST BASED ON TRADITION OR GOD'S WORD? #1

A close examination of the Scriptures will determine what is tradition and what is not. All things must be authorized by God's Word (Colossians 3:17). We must be able to turn to a passage which shows either by **command, example or implication** that whatever we believe and practice is done by the authority of the Lord. If we cannot, then that activity is tradition and not the commandment of God. The Lord's church, the church of Christ, is able to show Biblical authority for every activity in which it is engaged. Denominations of men are not able to do so.

The **worship of the church of Christ** is authorized by Scripture, not the traditions of men.

**SINGING** is worship. *"Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord"* (Ephesians 5:19). Singing in the first century was acappella (without the accompaniment of mechanical instruments of music). Our singing today is the same. Instruments of music were not introduced until several hundred years after the first century. This is God's Word, not tradition.

**PRAYER** is worship. *"Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him"* (Acts 12:5). Our prayer is directed unto God the Father in the name of Jesus the Son. This is God's Word, not tradition.

**PREACHING** is worship. When the church met at Troas, *"...Paul preached unto them..."* (Acts 20:7). We have Bible preaching and teaching at every service. This is God's Word, not tradition.

**THE LORD'S SUPPER** is worship. *"And upon the first day of the week... the disciples came together to break bread..."* (Acts 20:7). The church at Troas met every first day of the week to eat the Lord's supper (a memorial of the Lord's suffering and death). We eat the supper every first day just as they did. This is God's Word, not tradition.

**GIVING** is worship. *"Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store..."* (I Corinthians 16:2). We take up an offering every Lord's day just as they did. This is God's Word, not tradition.
