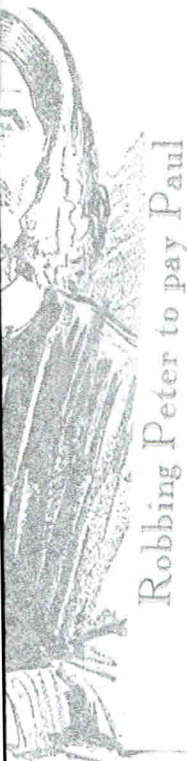

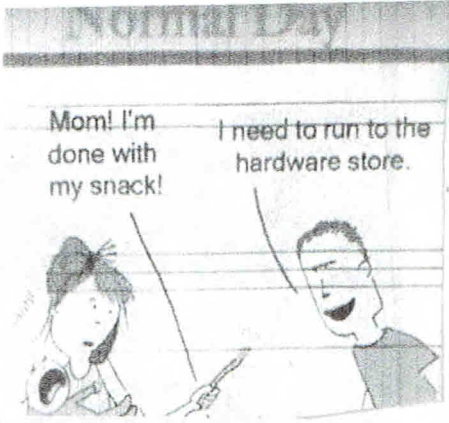
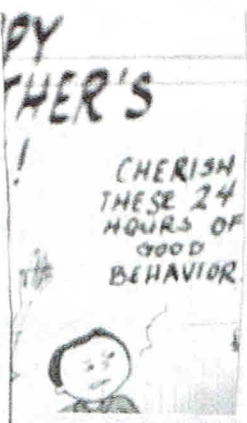

WHAT WAS THE PURPOSE OF THE CROSS?



"For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God" (I Corinthians 1:18). Without the cross, there is no hope for any of us. It was on the cross that Christ shed his blood, "and without shedding of blood is no remission" (Hebrews 9:22). There are in fact, many purposes for which Christ went to the cross. We will only mention a few.

Christ died on the cross to fulfill Old Testament prophecy. Jesus said, "...all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me" (Luke 24:44). To the two disciples on the road to Emmaus Jesus said, "O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself" (Luke 24:25-27). In Thessalonica, Paul went into the synagogue of the Jews and "reasoned with them out of the scriptures, Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ" (Acts 17:2-3). Contrary to the false doctrine of the 1,000 year reign of Christ on earth, Christ suffered and died on the cross just as the Old Testament scriptures said He would.

Christ died on the cross to take away the Old Testament. "Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross" (Col. 2:14). The Old Testament is spoken of as a "vail" and then says, "which vail is done away in Christ" (II Cor. 3:14). Read all of chapter 3.

Christ died on the cross to establish the New Testament. "The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached..." (Luke 16:16). "For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. For a testament is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth" (Hebrews 9:16-17). "He taketh away the first that he may establish the second" (Hebrews 10:9). "...A new covenant...made the first old" (Heb. 8:13).

This Month in History

MAY 1, 1931

Empire State Building Opens

The Empire State Building is located on Fifth Avenue in New York City and stands at 1,454 feet tall. The building's Art Deco architecture and observation decks make it a popular tourist attraction, with about 4 million visitors a year. The building has been featured in many movies, television shows, and books.

MAY 6, 1937

Hindenburg Disaster

The German airship Hindenburg burst into flames near Lakehurst, New Jersey, following a trans-Atlantic voyage. The hydrogen-filled rigid airship burned in less than a minute. Thirty six of the 97 passengers and crew were killed. The inferno was caught on film and witnessed

by a commentator who famously exclaimed "Oh, the humanity!" The accident effectively ended commercial airship travel.

MAY 10, 1994

Former Political Prisoner Mandela Elected

Former political prisoner Nelson Mandela was elected the first president of South Africa and became the country's first Black head of state. In the 40s and 50s, Mandela fought against apartheid, was arrested repeatedly, and imprisoned for 27 years starting in 1962.

MAY 20, 1873

Levi's Jeans Invented

Businessman Levi Strauss and tailor Jacob Davis received a patent for work pants that were reinforced

with copper rivets. Originally called "waist overalls", the pants became very popular with laborers and by the 1930s were being marketed to women. Today, Levi Strauss & Co. is a global leader in apparel and sells products in over 100 countries.

MAY 22, 1980

Pac-Man Released

Pac-Man, originally called "Puck Man" in Japan, is a maze arcade game featuring a dot eating orb with a mouth. It's one of the most influential video games of all time, was a commercial success, and remains one of the highest-grossing video games. The original game spawned Ms. Pac-Man, an animated children's show, several pop songs, and a board game.
