



WHAT DID PAUL MEAN WHEN HE TOLD TIMOTHY TO "WATCH THOU IN ALL THINGS"?

od has always commanded his people to "watch." It means to "be alert, If to give attention, to be careful, to be on guard, not to be found sleeping." It suggests we have enemies and we must watch lest they come upon us and destroy us. In the Old Testament, there were watchmen over the vineyard, flock, city, camp. The watchman was to sound a warning when danger was coming. When he did not, he was at fault and to be condemned.

Elders and preachers especially are "watchmen." They issue warnings of error and false doctrine in spiritual matters (Rom. 6:17-18; Heb. 13:17). Ezekiel 3:17 and 33:6-7 are good examples of a watchman. Jesus said that only the Truth can save (John 8:32), all else is error and condemns the soul (I John 3:4). Paul the apostle commanded Timothy to "watch" so he would be able to warn both the wicked and the righteous.

As far as the Christian is concerned, there are many things we must "watch."

- 1) We must watch our thoughts. "Bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ" (II Cor. 10:5). Thoughts can be sinful (Maatthew
- 2) We must watch our speech. "Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth" (Eph. 4:29). "For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned" (Matt. 12:37).
- 3) We must watch our appearance. We are to adorn (dress) ourselves in modest apparel (II Timothy 2:9). Immodest dress is sinful.
- 4) Jesus said to all, "Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come" (Matthew 24:42). We are to "watch with all perseverance" (Eph. 6:18), "watch unto prayer" (I Peter 4:7), "watch and be sober" (I Thess. 5:6), watch, stand fast in the faith, act like men, be strong (I Cor. 16:13).
