

That which a sinner MUST DO to become a saint is the same thing he/ she does to be saved or become a Christian. This is called God's "plan of salvation." That is, God has devised a plan whereby men can be saved from

their sins. Sinners must obey God's plan in order to be saved from their

sins and go to heaven when they die. A thorough study of God's plan reveals five basic steps.

1) One must HEAR the word of God. Jesus said, "Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me" (John 6:45).

2) One must BELIEVE the word of God and in Jesus the Christ. Faith comes by hearing God's word (Romans 1:17) and "...without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" (Hebrews 11:6). Jesus said, "... ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins" (John 8:24). Salvation is found in no other name than the name of Jesus the Christ (John 14:6; Acts 4:12).

3) One must REPENT of their sins. Except one repents, he will perish (Luke 13:3,5). "... Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins..." (Acts 2:38). God "...commandeth all men every where to repent" (Acts 17:30).

4) One must CONFESS faith in Jesus as the Son of God. "With the mouth, confession is made unto salvation" (Romans 10:10). The man from Ethiopia confessed, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God" (Acts 8:37).

5) One must BE BAPTIZED in water for the forgiveness of sins. Jesus said, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved..." (Mark 16:16). Saul was told to "...be baptized, and wash away thy sins..." (Acts 22:16). Water baptism puts one INTO Christ where we become a new man, and at that moment, we are made free (forgiven) from our sins (Romans 6:3-6, 17-18). Baptism saves us (I Peter 3:21).

One must CONTINUE FAITHFUL unto the Lord. Only the faithful will be saved (Revelation 2:10; I Corinthians 15:58). One can't obey and


